Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our topic this term, we have arranged a trip to Astley Hall, where the children will take part in two workshops:

- Introduction in the Great Hall - pupils will meet the Astley Hall maid and find out about the plague in Chorley in 1631.
- Visit the Astley Walled Garden to look at and collect herbs. Visit the maids' "Still Room" to find out more about herbs in medicines and make a plague bag.

The trip will take place on **Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> May**. We will leave school at 9.30am and return by 3.30pm.

The cost of the trip is £7.60 per child. This includes a range of educational activities and the cost of the coach. There is no obligation to contribute and no pupil in the group will be omitted from the visit, but it will be necessary to have substantial voluntary contributions in order that the visit takes place. However, if insufficient contributions/donations are received by Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> May, it may be necessary to cancel the visit.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch. Those children on school dinners will be given a packed lunch. School uniform is to be worn and sensible shoes. Please dress appropriately for the weather as some activities take place outside. Children can bring a maximum of £5.00 spending money.
