Learning Log for Year 5

For the next twelve weeks homework will be a learning log task. Each child will be issued with a book to record all their work. The children are asked to complete a task once a week from the list below. More information and examples of learning logs can be found at:

1. Imagine you are a reporter for a top magazine. Write an imaginary report about the invaders to England.
2. Design a wanted poster for a Scot or Pict that has been invading England and causing death.
3. Design and make a suitable advertisement for a warrior to come and help King Vortigern.
4. Write a persuasive letter to either Horsa or Hengest to come and help their brother Vortigern to battle against the invading Scots and Picts.
5. Research and write a fact file about the life of an Anglo-Saxon's daily life.
6. Paint or sketch a picture of a battle between the Brits and the invaders.
7. Design a word search or crossword about the invaders to England at this time.
8. Write a character profile of either a farming Brit or an invader to England
9. Write an imaginary short story about a battle and invasion to England. You can choose to either write it from a Brits point of view or an invaders point of view.
10. Write a book review about the class novel, can you predict what might happen at the end of the novel?
11. Write a set of instructions for making bread.
12. Can you develop and write a code to a friend using the Anglo Saxon primitive writing? You will have to include the code and the message.
13. Research and report about what was found at Sutton Hoo, what was the significance of the discovery?
14. Describe what it must have been like sailing and rowing from Denmark to invade England. How did the warriors feel? Remember to use lots of descriptive language to paint the scene in the readers mind.
15. Draw a picture or make a model of a long boat.

Remember pupils are expected to read for a minimum 15 minutes each evening from their reading book and record it in their "Reading Records". Learn the times tables 12x12
