3. Percy penguin is standing on a block of ice. It is cube shaped. Draw and label cube shaped objects you find at home.

4. What camping and survival skills would we need for a trip to the Arctic or Antarctic?



5. Would you like to live on the Antarctic? Why? Or Why not? Give at least 5 reasons.

6. Design and make an igloo.

7. How is Antarctica different to England?

8. Polly the Polar bear used 16 circles to make a snowman. What could it look like?

9. It is too cold for trees to grow on the Poles, where do animals live and how do they survive the cold weather?

10. Which animals live in the Polar regions? Choose one and write a description of them.

11. Put some ice in different places in your house. Where does it melt the quickest/slowest?

These are ideas that your child can choose from and do in any order over the Autumn term. They may use their own ideas that will fit into our topic. They can record their findings in any way they choose.... Be creative! These will be shared in class on various days of the week. The children will earn stickers for everything they do!
