

A Typical Day at Shevington Vale.



Times	What happens....
8.50am	Doors open
8.50am-9.10am	<b>First lesson</b> -Morning Mission
9.10am-9.30am	<b>Second lesson</b> -Spelling groups by stage of what the children can do –mixed groups across school
9.30am – 10am	<b>Lesson three</b> – Guided Reading
10am- 12.00pm	<b>Lessons four and five</b> – no fixed timings- play times to be determined by the children and staff depending on the lesson and its need
Lunch Time 12.00 pm-1.15pm	Children come back into school at 1.00pm for quiet reading sessions.
1.15pm-3.15pm	<b>Afternoon Lessons</b> No playtime in Y3 –Y6 Y1- Y2 take a break as necessary depending on the lesson
3.30pm	Home Time

The Reception Class has outdoor sessions as a part of every lesson and so have access to the outside all the time and so do not have a fixed playtime. This is considered 'best practice'.

At our school we involve the children in decision making at every opportunity and so the children will be involved in deciding when a playtime is needed taking into consideration the tasks that they are working on at the time.  
This allows flexibility for all and it also avoids congestion on the areas outside.

A daily 'Act of Worship' takes place for every child. Groupings and venue change as the week progresses however it is usually held at 1.20pm each day.
