<b>LISTENING AND RESPONDING</b>			
To listen to longer, spoken passages in familiar contexts			
To identify the main points in a spoken passage.			
To identify the detail within spoken passages			
To respond appropriately to the key information.			
<b>SPEAKING</b>			
To take part in short conversations			
To ask simple questions to gather information.			
To answer simple questions to provide information.			
Showing an ability to give extended responses.			
Is able to make themselves understood more easily.			
To prepare and give a short talk.			
<b>READING AND RESPONDING</b>			
To identify the main points in a written passage.			
To identify the detail in a written passage.			
To read a range of real-life reference materials e.g. simple newspapers, menus, instructions etc.			
To begin to read aloud confidently.			
<b>WRITING</b>			
Is able to select what to write about using familiar topics.			
To write using simple sentence constructions.			
To include present plans involving everyday activities.			
Is able to makes themselves understood more easily.			
To use glossaries and French dictionaries to look up and check unknown words.
