To follow instructions and to show they are understood.

READING AND RESPONDING			
To show understanding of a simple text by reading aloud and identifying the main points.			
To read aloud simple sentences.			
To highlight familiar words within a text.			
WRITING			
To write a simple sentence about the topic focus with the support of a word bank.			
To write familiar missing words in a “cloze” sentence.			
To label familiar objects linked to topic.
